My sisters, Lori, Carolyn and I come from a family of girls. Our parents met as teenagers in Falmouth, Cornwall, England and shared a 69-year love story. It all started at a local football game, when our mother offered my dad a date square, and he cheekily replied, "I'd rather have a date". Their life journey brought them to Canada where they raised our family, and they were always heavily involved in their church and community.

Life took a challenging turn when our mother began showing signs of dementia. Despite his advanced age, our Dad did his best to care for her, but when he fell and suffered a heart attack, the family faced a crisis. Dad was 93 and could no longer care for Mum. We have always been a family of "doers" but we realized we needed help.

Desperate for a solution, we turned to our community. We found solace in St. Joseph's Villa for mum. The care she receives there is nothing short of extraordinary. The staff treat her like family. She's always clean, well-fed, and her hair is beautifully done. They make sure she's comfortable and happy, attending to her every need.

When our father ultimately needed hospice care, we discovered Margaret's Place Hospice just steps away from the Villa on the same healthcare campus. Margaret's Place is nestled beside Spring Creek Ravine and is surrounded by nature and wildlife. It was a blessing. Dad was admitted to the hospice, and we were able to wheel Mum over from the Villa to visit him daily. They held hands, watched the birds, and we sang hymns together. It was a miracle during a dark time.

As Dad's condition worsened, the family was deeply supported by the staff at Margaret's Place. They provided unwavering support, allowing us to spend precious moments together. I stayed overnight one night with Dad, and the staff tended to our every need setting up a sleeper for me in Dad's room and provided all the comforts

The hospice staff went above and beyond, even helping care for Mum when she visited. They truly treated us

It is a blessing to have both of them cared for so well.

Today, we continue to visit mum daily at the Villa, support the Villa's fundraising events and participate in daily life with our Mum. It has become a home away from home for us as well.

Our generous donors have made a significant impact on essential care needs throughout the Villa, including:

Dietary Department Upgrades:

Thanks to the exceptional generosity of some very special donors, \$170,000 was donated to replace outdated equipment in our dietary department. With new ovens, an 80-gallon soup kettle, a tilting skillet, and induction burners, our staff can now efficiently deliver over 1,500 delicious and nutritious meals to our residents every day.

- Adult Day Program (ADP) **Renovations:** To meet new infection control protocols and enhance the environment for our program participants, we renovated the ADP space. The kitchen was rebuilt, and all three program washrooms were renovated to be fully accessible. Additionally, new flooring and a fresh coat of paint throughout the kitchen, bathrooms, and hallways brightened up the space.
- New Resident Bath Chairs: We acquired new bath chairs equipped with weigh scales to meet the latest Ministry requirements.
- Therapeutic Bathtubs: Two new therapeutic bathtubs were installed in resident home areas.
- Additional Critical Needs: Numerous other critical needs were met, ensuring our residents receive the best possible care.

In total, approximately \$500,000 was provided to the Villa for upgrades this past year.
